a letter from

OUR FOUNDER

Revive family,

On Sunday, September 13, 2022, three weeks into my time at UT, I stood up in front of my fraternity and gave them a 5-minute presentation. The presentation was for a new ministry I had the vision of starting at UT. In this presentation, I asked my fraternity brothers "What impact do you want to have while you're here?" I reminded them of Acts 17:26-27; "From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed



times in history and the boundaries of their lands. God did this so that they would seek Him and perhaps reach out for Him and find Him, though He is not far from any one of us." I told them that God had put us right here, right now, to reach our campus and make disciples.

I had no idea what would come out of that presentation. I was hoping that, at best, by the time I graduated in 2026, maybe the ball would be rolling and we could hire somebody else to take care of the rest. I could not have imagined the extent of God's faithfulness to us over the last couple of years. I had more anxiety and fear about this idea than faith. But in spite of me, and in spite of the flaws of our team, God has done what only He can do so that only He may get the credit.

What has happened over the last two and a half years has been nothing short of incredible. Thousands of students have poured through our doors on Wednesday nights to hear the gospel, eat some free food, make friends, and connect with God. The best team of students in the whole world has come together to labor for the sake of this ministry. Worship leaders and pastors from all over the city of Austin have rallied behind our ministry and supported us. We've reached tens of thousands of people with our social media. We've connected with students after events and had the opportunity to plug them into the community. One student has even been baptized as a result of reconnecting with God through Revive. We know many more of these stories are to come.

I have endless gratitude for everyone who has helped in the formation of our ministry. But there is one particular group of partners in our ministry that I have a unique appreciation for. And that is folks like you who choose to support us with our dollars. You have nothing to gain personally by supporting our ministry. You will not be on stage or on the website. Most of our students will never know you donated. You have chosen to support us because, among other reasons, you believe that the Kingdom of God needs to be advanced on our campus. You have chosen to buy into God's mission for the world and selflessly support us in making disciples here on UT's campus. I want you to know that I am beyond grateful for that level of trust and support. Your generosity is an encouragement to my soul. It is an act of faithfulness that I recognize and celebrate. And my hope is that one day, when we finish the race and reconvene in our eternal home, we will be able to lock arms together once again and reminisce on just how good God was to us and just how blessed we truly were. I'm grateful for you and I'm praying for you.










Budget Breakdown by %


Fa24-Sp25 Fundraising Progress


